## Keep in Mind .....

### 1. Introductions

- Introduce officials.
- Ask students to introduce themselves.
- Ask coaches to shake hands, introduce themselves, and to sit together in back of room.

### 2. Rules

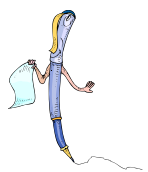
- Read "Important Rules" sheet at the start of each game (located in your packet).

### 3. Reading the Questions

- Announce whether it's a toss up or bonus question.
- Announce question category.
- Announce whether multiple choice or short answer.
- Read that question.

### 4. Who Won?

- Fill out official score sheet and get signatures.



<p><b>Toss-Up ?</b> No consultation among team members. (Shhhhhhhh)</p>	<p><b>Bonus ?</b> Consultation is allowed, but the captain must answer.</p>

**Challenge?**

- Ask timekeeper to stop the clock
